Technical features of Deco pieces: Travertine, Galaxy, Precious Stones and Art Gallery collections.

Pieces of Travertine, Galaxy, Precious Stones and Art Gallery collections are produced by applying a combination of mica, precious crystals, lusterware methods and gold.

Once the gold is applied, it melts and becomes an integral part of the piece. This gold will not come off.

However, small amounts of dust might be left on the surface of the pieces, as a result of the whole production process. This dust is not part of the piece, but merely leftover dust that hasn't melted.

Also mention that, since these are precious materials, they are fired at high temperatures and therefore there is no possibility of the material falling off, but if it can be damaged by acids.

This is a specific technical feature, typical for this kind of product.

Cleaning the Decos after installing.

Once the Deco has been installed, all eventual residues of grout still present on the surface need to be removed immediately, before such residues dry out and solidify. A soft sponge and water is the recommended combination.

When cleaning the Decos, no acid substances or abrasive sponges may be applied. The only recommended tools for cleaning the Decos is neutral soap, in combination with soft sponges or pieces of cloth.
